รายวิชาภาษาอังกฤษ ระดับชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 5 เน้นพัฒนาทักษะการฟัง พูด อ่าน และเขียนภาษาอังกฤษ โดยให้ผู้เรียนฝึกฝนการปฏิบัติตามคำสั่ง คำขอร้อง และคำแนะนำที่ง่าย ๆ ผ่านการฟังและการอ่าน ผู้เรียนจะได้ฝึกอ่านออกเสียงประโยค ข้อความ และบทกลอนสั้น ๆ อย่างถูกต้องตามหลักการอ่านและการออกเสียง ฝึกการสื่อสารในชีวิตประจำวันด้วยการพูด และเขียนข้อความที่เกี่ยวข้องกับตนเอง ครอบครัว และสิ่งรอบตัว ผู้เรียนจะได้ฝึกการแสดงความรู้สึก ความต้องการ และเหตุผลสั้น ๆ ในสถานการณ์ง่าย ๆ พร้อมทั้งฝึกการใช้ถ้อยคำ ท่าทาง และน้ำเสียงที่สุภาพตามวัฒนธรรมของเจ้าของภาษา และฝึกทักษะในการค้นคว้าและนำเสนอ ข้อมูลด้วยการพูดและการเขียน

ผลการเรียนรู้

2. อ่านออกเสียงประโยค ข้อความ และบทกลอนสั้น ๆ ได้อย่างถูกต้องตามหลักการอ่านและการออกเสียง
3. บอกใจความสำคัญและตอบคำถามจากการฟังและอ่านบทสนทนา นิทาน หรือเรื่องสั้นง่าย ๆ
4. พูดและเขียนได้ตอบในการสื่อสารระหว่างบุคคลเกี่ยวกับข้อมูลของตนเอง เพื่อน และสิ่งรอบตัว
5. ใช้คำสั่ง คำขอร้อง คำขออนุญาต และให้คำแนะนำง่าย ๆ อย่างถูกต้อง
